

A local charity that helps teen parents is looking to you for some help.

Terra Centre says that they are completely out of clothing for boys between the age of 18 months and four years.

Danielle Higdon with the Centre says they're hoping Edmontonians can step up and help, as they have so many times in the past.

"The Edmonton community has been quick to come together when we're in need, which is why we're currently at storage capacity for other kinds of in kind donations."



Higdon says right now they're out of clothing for that age group for all seasons, so the clothing donated doesn't have to be only summer.

"We know that at that age children are growing out of their clothing at a quick pace, so we do see a higher turnaround of mothers coming in to get clothing for their children, not just right now, but for upcoming months when sizes can change," she says.

The donations need to be new, or very gently used, so that the young families can get as much wear as possible before the children grow out of them.
