### 2020 at a Glance

#### Adapt, Pivot, Deliver

2020 was an interesting year to say the least. We all faced a global pandemic and massive changes to our funding sources required us to quickly pivot to ensure we could continue to meet the needs of the teen parent families we serve. Thanks to donor support, we were able to:

- Offer new socially-distanced groups and supports, including virtual programming
- Complete more than 850 curbside deliveries of essential items to our participant families
- In collaboration with Edmonton Public Schools, continue to provide uninterrupted education and childcare services at Braemar School.

## You are Not Alone:

Campaign for Mental Health Supports



When the pandemic hit, many things changed for Terra including some of our funding partners needing to redirect their resources to support pandemic recovery. While funding was reduced, the need for mental supports did not. To ensure our families' mental health needs were fully met, we launched our You Are Not Alone Campaign.

Thank you for showing teen parents they are not alone and contributing to this important initiative. Together, we raised over \$50,000 which enabled us to:

- Deliver 781 therapy sessions to Terra participants in 2020
- Transition to alternative methods of therapy with facetime, phone and text sessions during the pandemic
- Deliver agency-wide staff training on suicide and self-harm training to over 40 staff and volunteers
- Host virtual weekly mindfulness classes at Braemar.

Over our 50-year history, Terra's programs have continued to evolve and change. As we embark on our next 50 years, we realize that our downtown building does not meet our needs and is not equipped to help us achieve our vision for the future.
